


Wine List



—White Wine—

2016 Viura, Pleno, Navarra, Spain (V+) – Bright straw yellow in colour and fruity aroma this wine has a smooth, fresh, dry and well-balanced finish. Viura is the white grape of Rioja.

2016 Las Condes Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile (V) - Pale lemon colour in the glass with aromas of pineapple, citrus and mango and soft tropical notes. The palate is lively and fresh with tropical fruit and citrus dominating with a pleasantly lengthy finish.

2016 Pinot Grigio, Amori, Veneto, Italy (V+) – A firm favourite here, has a fragrant floral bouquet, while the palate has a fresh finesse and an elegant mouth-feel.

2017 Chardonnay, Freedom Cross, Franschhoek, South Africa (V+)- Refreshing white with ripe apple with tropical flavours leading to a clean and dry finish

2017 Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Southern Lights, New Zealand (V+) – A fantastic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Zingy and fresh with a long flavoursome aftertaste. This is one of the very few New Zealand Sauvignon Blancs made with the addition of a small amount of Semillon which adds a little roundness, body and also zest.

—Rosé Wine—

2016 Garnacha Rosado, Pleno, Navarra, Spain (V+) - Vibrant pink in the glass with vibrant summer fruit on the nose. On the palate you'll find delicate refreshing summer berry fruits with a tint of spice on the finish. Dry on the finish.

2016 Pinot Grigio Blush, Amori, Veneto, Italy (V+) – A copper pink rosé from Northern Italy's Venezie region with gently fragrant summer fruits on the nose and delicate strawberry fruit on the palate. Fruitily off-dry.

—Red Wine—

2016 Tempranillo, Pleno, Navarra (V+) - *The deep red colour hints at the richness of the palate. Fresh red berry fruit on the nose with a smooth and round mouth-feel. Navarra is the next door province to Rioja, and Tempranillo ("the little early one") the Rioja grape.*

2016 Merlot, Vicuna, Central Valley, Chile (V+) - *An intense violet colour with aromas of blackberry and plum leaping from the glass. The palate follows suit dominated by plum, maybe even a hint of blueberry and a touch of spice. Smooth sweet tannins on the finish, a very enjoyable glass of red.*

2015 Malbec Reserva, Gouguenheim, Mendoza (V+) *Malbec is an Argentinian success story and this wine from Patricio Gouguenheim is a lovely example with big cherry and coffee aromas, chunky flavours of damson and a subtle toasty oak finish.*

2013 Côtes du Rhône, Mas Arnaud, France (V+) - *Blending syrah with grenache in roughly equal proportions, the new vintage exhibits the typical luscious bramble fruit of this estate, partnered with a spicy complexity with herbaceous notes and flavours of liquorice*

2016 Rioja Crianza, Sancho Garces (V) - *This is proper Rioja, with flavours of fresh, lush berry fruits balanced with very well judged use of oak. The barrel ageing lends the wine extra character, roundness and complexity, with flavours of cinnamon and exotic spice swirling around the generous red fruits.*

2013 Millefiori, Rosso del Veneto, Italy (V+) - *Terrific new wave Italian red. Valpolicella grape varieties are air dried to add intensity, mixed with a little Cabernet to make a juicy modern wine which is still 100% Italian in style.*

—Prosecco—

Botter Prosecco (V+) - *With finer bubbles than most Proseccos, Botter's Extra Dry Prosecco is more of a champagne style than more typical lively green-apple Proseccos. Fine bubbles release aromas of herbs, toast and soft citrus fruits. The palate is not too dry (despite its name) with fresh fruit salad, a little minerality and a zesty, dry finish.*

—Champagne—

Blanc de Noirs, Michel Guilleminot (V+) - *100% Pinot Noir from a great grower and aged for a full three years in bottle. Look for fresh, fragrant fruit on the nose; crunchy berry fruit flavours combining with a classic biscuity note and a gentle mousse; and an appetizing, pure, vibrant accent.*

Brut Rosé, Michel Guilleminot (V+) - *A wonderful Summer berry aroma. There is still a very definite Champagne character to the palate with a creamy mousse combining with notes of brioche and red fruit.*

Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut (V+) - *Cellared for four years to add complexity and presented in a curvaceous, 17th century-style bottle, this is sparkling rosé at its finest. Salmon pink champagne with lively raspberry and strawberry aromas. Fresh and zingy with a fine mousse and soft red fruit flavours.* **Bottle £70**
